

Natural gas to LPG Changeover Training Manual (CoNGLP1)

Designed to help plumbers and heating engineers prepare for the Nationally Accredited Certification Scheme (ACS) changeover assessments from Natural Gas to Liquefied Petroleum Gas, this course consists of six generic core Liquefied Petroleum Gas ACS modules (1 to 6) and four Liquefied Petroleum Gas sector specific modules (7 to 10).

A final module is also provided to test knowledge and understanding of modules 1 to 10 and give an indication of progress, and once the training is complete the candidate should be ready to sit the Natural Gas to Liquefied Petroleum Gas changeover ACS assessment.

All the sectors of the LPG changeover assessments are covered, including:

- PD Permanent Dwellings.
- RPH Residential Park Homes.
- LAV Leisure Accommodation Vehicles.
- B Boats.

What do trainees need?

Candidates must hold a Certificate of Competence in any Core Gas Safety Assessment or a valid ACS-aligned Gas Services S/NVQ.
