

Gas Foundation Training Materials

If you want to enter the gas industry, your starting point could be our Domestic and Non-Domestic Gas Foundation course, designed for ACS Category 2 and 3 trainees (Category 2 means you hold a recognised qualification in the mechanical services engineering sector, e.g. plumbing, but don't have gas training and experience, while Category 3 means you're new to the gas industry altogether).

It's a comprehensive and structured training programme using a mix of individual sessions and theoretical and practical assessments, to give you the knowledge and skills you'll need for ACS training and assessments. The course consists of a total of 33 days in a college environment plus 'on the job' training under the supervision of a Gas Safe registered installer.

Gas Foundation Candidate Portfolio

This is where you'll record all the training you undertake, and acts as evidence of your knowledge and experience so you can undertake the ACS assessments.

On completion of the training and portfolio, you'll get a BPEC Gas Foundation certificate, which qualifies you to undertake the relevant ACS assessments.
